NOTE: Because of continued updates, sales tax data is subject to revision. Beginning with July-August 1995 data, the sales tax reporting system was changed to a different format, which has delayed the release of data. It should also be noted that in some cases businesses may have invalid zip codes which do not match up with the zip code of the city where the business is located. For example, a business located in Sioux Falls may list a mailing address other than Sioux Falls on their sales tax form. When a situation like this occurs, the sales for this business are reported with county data instead of with the city data. Because of this, city data published prior to May-June 1995 is not always comparable with the sales tax data generated by the new system. Comparisons included in this issue do include revised sales tax data for 1994 as produced by the new system.
