Marcia Bradley is a happy camper. She loves antiques, she loves her business, and she loves customer service.

This month, she celebrates her tenth anniversary as the owner of FB Antiques, a multi-dealer antique mall on Chamberlain's Main Street. What started out as a 700 square foot antique business now encompasses about 6,000 square feet, with 13 dealers and more than 20 active consigners selling antiques including furniture, glassware and jewelry.

Customers from all over make their way to her door - not just from every corner of the United States, but from all over the world.

Marcia runs the shop mostly by herself, six days a week. Her husband helps out during his off time, and one dealer works a few hours a month in lieu of rent.

Marcia became an SDR member shortly after opening her store - primarily for the credit card processing.

"I didn't want to go hunting around, and **I had been told you guys had the best rate.** I checked into it, and signed up," she says.

She's still on our credit card processing program, but now finds even greater value in other aspects of her membership.

Jason Quam is the second-generation owner of Dakota Alert in Elk Point, employing about a dozen people. The business has been in its location near I-29 for six years, after outgrowing their previous location on Main Street.

The company, which incorporated in 1991, manufactures wireless security systems including driveway alarms, motion detectors, and vehicle sensors. Their products are distributed not just in the United States, but globally.

"I enjoy doing what we do," Jason says. "Being able to find a niche and fill that niche, to provide a decent product for a reasonable price."

He also enjoys dealing with his customers. "I get to talk to customers all over the country on a daily basis, and we get international calls periodically too, so we know our products are going elsewhere in the world. Just to make the connections is what I enjoy most here."

Dakota Alert has been an SDR member for 18 years.
